DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

Article I

God is a person who has revealed Himself as a Trinity in unity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit – three persons and yet one God (Deut. 6:4; Matt. 28:19; 1 Cor. 8:6).

Article II

The Bible, including both the Old and New Testaments, is a divine revelation, the original autographs of which were verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit (2 Tim. 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21).

Article III

Jesus Christ is the image of the invisible God, which is to say, He is himself very God; He took upon Himself our nature, being conceived by the Holy Ghost and born of the Virgin Mary; He died upon the cross as a substitution sacrifice for the sin of the world; He arose from the dead in the body in which He was crucified; He ascended into heaven in that body glorified, where He is now, our interceding High Priest; He will come again personally and visibly to set up His kingdom and to judge the quick and the dead (Col. 1:5; Phil. 2:5-8; Matt. 1:18-25; 1 Peter 2:24-25; Luke 24; Heb. 4:14-16; Acts 1:9-11; 1 Thess. 4:16-18; Matt. 25:31-46; Rev. 11:15-17; 20:4-6, 11-15).

Article IV

Humans were created in the image of God but fell into sin and, in that sense, are lost; this is true of all people, and except a person be born again he or she cannot see the kingdom of God; salvation is by grace through faith in Christ who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree; the retribution of the wicked and unbelieving and the reward of the righteous are everlasting and, as the reward is conscious, so is the retribution (Gen. 1:26-27; Rom. 3:10,23; John 3:3; Acts 13:38-39; 4:12; John 3:16; Matt. 25:46; 2 Cor. 5:1; 2 Thess. 1:7-10).

Article V

The Church is an elect company of believers baptized by the Holy Spirit into one body; its mission is to witness concerning its Head, Jesus Christ, preaching the gospel among all nations; it will be caught up to meet the Lord in the air when He appears to set up His kingdom (Acts 2:41; 15:13-17; Eph. 1:3-6; 1 Cor. 12:12-13; Matt. 28:19-20; Acts 1:6-8; 1 Thess. 4:16-18).

Psalms 1:1-6

¹ Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

² But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

³ And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

⁴ The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away.
